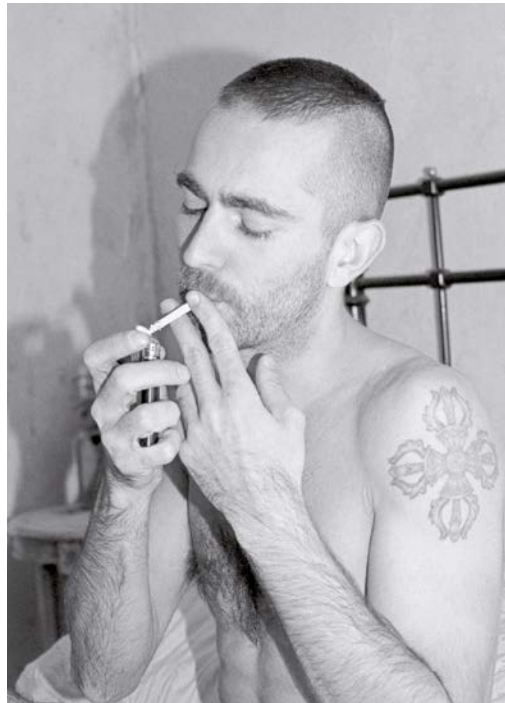

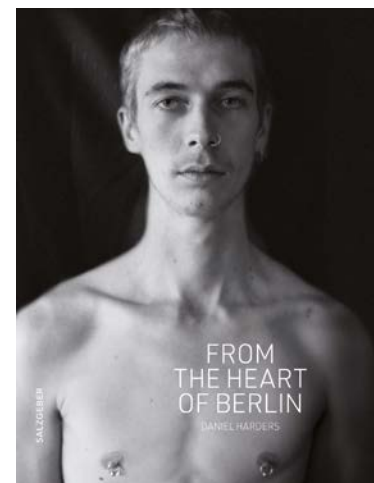
## FROM THE HEART OF BERLIN

Male bodies beyond clichés, the search for identity, and, always, the ever-changing faces of Berlin: these are the themes Daniel Harders explores in this book. "From the Heart of Berlin" is a photographic journey back in time to the early 2000s, to a city ripe with possibilities—unconventional, free and, above all, real.

Born in Mülheim an der Ruhr in 1975, Daniel Harders has been working as a freelance photographer in Berlin since 2002. He attended the Ostkreuzschule for Photography from 2006 to 2009, where he studied and graduated under Ute Mahler. Harders is an analog photographer and co-founder of the analog photo lab PS15, where he develops his own prints. "From the Heart of Berlin" is his second book following "Reverse Intimacy."
